## ITINERARY

**Day One** – Departing early this morning, we'll head to Washington, D.C., making a rest stop en route. Upon arrival in Washington, you'll have time to have lunch on your own. This afternoon we'll take a guided tour of the Washington National Cathedral. The cathedral is the second largest in the U.S. and the sixth largest in the world and is located on Mount St. Albans, the highest point in Washington, D.C. This majestic Gothic style cathedral was constructed with Indiana limestone and contains over 200 stained glass windows. Following the tour of the National Cathedral we'll transfer by coach to the Kennedy Center for a guided tour. The tour will include the majestic Hall of States, Hall of Nations and five of the Center's main theaters, including its three grand performance halls (the Concert Hall, Opera House and Eisenhower



Theater). Along the tour you'll see many extraordinary gifts from the governments of more than 60 countries that make the Kennedy Center truly an international destination. Following the Kennedy Center tour the coach will transfer us to Tony & Joe's Seafood Place at Washington Harbor for dinner this evening. After dinner, we'll take a brief drive along the National Mall for a "Night Lights" tour of the monuments and memorials before checking into our hotel, the Best Western Falls Church Inn. (Dinner)



**Day Two** – After breakfast at the hotel, the motorcoach will transfer us into D.C. for a day of sightseeing. Our first stop this morning is the White House Visitors Center followed by a guided tour of the Capitol Building. This afternoon is free for you to enjoy the many museums along the National Mall at your own pace. Dinner is included this evening at Phillips Flagship before transferring back to the hotel. (Breakfast, Dinner)



**Day Three** – After breakfast this morning, the coach will transfer us to George Washington's Mount Vernon. Our visit will include a film at the Ford Orientation Center, audio tour of the mansion and grounds (including a dozen out-buildings), admission to the Donald W. Reynolds Museum and tour of the Distillery and Grist Mill. Lunch is included today at the Mount Vernon Inn. On our way back to Washington, D.C. this afternoon, we'll stop in Alexandria, VA for some free time to shop and have dinner on your own (Breakfast, Lunch)

**Day Four** – Following breakfast and checkout this morning, we'll take everyone to the Kalorama neighborhood of Washington, D.C. for the Around the World Embassy Tour. For one day each year, many of the foreign embassies in Washington, D.C. open their doors to the public, offering a rare look at the diverse cultures through artists and artisans, performers, food and a wide range of cultural programming. Late this afternoon, we'll depart for home making a 1-hour dinner stop (at your own expense) en route (Breakfast).
