ISSUE C: Pension Contributors' Protection Act

PASR will promote passage of legislation to prevent further abuse and political manipulation of the retirement systems that includes the following provisions:

- Charge Pennsylvania's Auditor General with the responsibility of periodically reviewing the retirement system's actuarial assumptions, projections, and practices.
- Require the Public Employee Retirement Commission to schedule public hearings on all proposals to amend the retirement codes before issuing its actuarial notes to the General Assembly.
- Require the legislature to provide no less than two weeks from when the Commission issues an actuarial note before either the House or Senate can vote final passage on a bill to amend the retirement codes.
- Empower the PSERS Board of Trustees to express opinions on proposals affecting the retirement system and enable PSERS to challenge legally those who might seek to force them to abdicate their fiduciary responsibilities. The PSERS Board of Trustees must be allowed to select and hire independent legal council and have greater control of its budget and decisions concerning the hiring and compensation provided to its employees.
