ITINERARY

Day One

Departing early this morning you'll head for Connecticut making the customary rest and lunch (at your own expense) stops along the way. This afternoon, you will check into the Holiday Inn Express, Newington, CT, just outside of Hartford. Dinner is included at a local restaurant this evening. **(DINNER)**

Day Two

After breakfast, you'll continue your journey to Maine, stopping mid-day in the lovely town of Kennebunkport for lunch at your own expense (You'll return to Kennebunkport later in the week for a guided tour). This afternoon you will travel to Portland for a sightseeing cruise of Maine's rugged, rocky coast and picturesque lighthouses. Following the cruise you'll check into your hotel, the Best Western Merry Manor Inn, South Portland, ME Dinner is included this evening. (BREAKFAST, DINNER)



Day Three

After breakfast at the hotel, you'll travel to Bath, the "Ship-Builders" town and follow Maine's rich maritime history through the centuries. At the Maine Maritime Museum learn about boat building, sea captains and the lobstering industry. Discover the ways of life of coastal Maine and visit the museum's working waterfront. From Bath, you'll travel to Boothbay Harbor where you'll have time for lunch on your own in this delightful coastal village filled with shops, eateries and beautiful views of Maine's rocky coastline. After lunch, meet your local guide and see why the Boothbay Harbor Region is the "Soul of the Maine Coast". Explore quiet coves, rocky shores, meandering country roads, and beautiful lighthouses. Discover this beautiful coastal region including spectacular Ocean Point Drive, three lighthouses, salt water birds and local lobster fishermen. From Boothbay you'll travel to Belfast, ME and check into the Fireside Inn & Suites. All guest rooms here have an ocean view. Dinner is included this evening. (BREAKFAST, DINNER)



DAY Four

Following breakfast, you'll begin your day at the Penobscot Narrows Bridge and Observatory, the tallest bridge observatory open to the public in the world. Ride the elevator up 420 feet above the Penobscot River to a multi-level, floor to ceiling viewing platform and take in the 100-mile view.... all the way to Acadia! Next travel to Bar Harbor where you'll have free time to explore the waterfront downtown filled with shops, eateries, galleries and museums. Lunch is on your own today. This afternoon a local guide will take you on a tour of Bar Harbor and Acadia National Park. You will travel to the Peak of Cadillac Mountain for breath-taking views of the mountains and the Atlantic. Venture to Otter Point and experience the rocky cliffs jutting out into the crashing surf. Witness the wonder of Sieur De Mont Springs and the power of the surf at Thunder Hole. A Maine Lobster Dinner is included this evening. (BREAKFAST, DINNER)



Day Five

After breakfast and check-out, meet your guide and discover Maine's charming southern coast. Stop by York Beach and the famous Nubble Lighthouse for a photo-op at Maine's most photographed lighthouse where you'll hear about the long history of the keepers. Visit the quaint seaside town of Ogunquit where you will have time for lunch (at your own expense) and then visit the fishing village community of Perkins Cove. In Kennebunkport, enjoy views of the Bush Estate, Wedding Cake House and a tour of the Franciscan Monastery. Hear the history of this Maine coastal community as related by your local guide. Leaving Kennebunkport this afternoon you will travel to Newington, CT and check into the Holiday Inn Express. Dinner is included this evening at a local restaurant. (BREAKFAST, DINNER)



Day Six

After breakfast and check-out, you'll depart for home with wonderful memories of Maine's Southern Coast. The customary rest and meal stops (at your own expense) will be made en route. (BREAKFAST)

Insurance benefits are not payable for any loss due to, arising or resulting from: 1. suicide, attempted suicide or any intentionally self- inflicted injury of You, a Traveling Companion, Family Member or Business Partner booked to travel with You, while sane or insane; 2. an act of declared or undeclared war; 3. participating in maneuvers or training exercises of an armed service, except while participating in weekend or summer training for the reserve forces of the United States, including the National Guard; 4. riding or driving in races, or speed or endurance competitions or events; 5. mountaineering (engaging in the sport of scaling mountains generally requiring the use of picks, ropes, or other special equipment); 6. participating as a member of a team in an organized sporting competition; 7. participating in bodily contact sports, skydiving or parachuting, hang gliding or bungee cord jumping; 8. piloting or learning to pilot or acting as a member of the crew of any aircraft; 9. being Intoxicated, or under the influence of any controlled substance unless as administered or prescribed by a Legally Qualified Physician; 10. the commission of or attempt to commit a felony or being engaged in an illegal occupation; 11. normal childbirth or pregnancy (except Complications of Pregnancy) or voluntarily induced abortion; 12. dental treatment (except as coverage is otherwise specifically provided); 13. amounts which exceed the Maximum Benefit Amount for each coverage as shown in the Schedule of Benefits; 14. due to a Pre-Existing Condition, as defined in the Policy. If the event prevents You from reporting the cancellation, the 72-hour notice requirement does not apply; however, You must, if requested, provide proof that said event prevented him or her from reporting the cancellation within the specified period.
