ITINERARY

Day One – Departing early this morning, we'll pick up in Camp Hill and Easton before heading north to the Hudson Valley. Our first stop will be the Visitor's Center at West Point. Here we'll pick up a guide for a driving tour of the U.S. Military Academy at West Point. Your guide will tell you stories of West Point and its graduates who have shaped our nation. The tour stops at the Main Cadet Chapel, Trophy Point and the Plain. Following the tour you'll have lunch at a local restaurant. This afternoon, enjoy a wine tasting at Brotherhood Winery, America's Oldest Winery. Following the tour you will continue traveling north to Poughkeepsie, where you will have dinner at a local restaurant before checking into the Poughkeepsie Hampton Inn & Suites. This hotel features complimentary Wi-Fi, a pool and fitness center. Each room comes equipped with a coffee maker, flat screen TV, hair dryer, iron/ironing board. (LUNCH, DINNER)

Day Two – After breakfast at the hotel this morning, we will depart and head to the Mohonk Mountain House in New Paltz, NY. Travel & Leisure Magazine ranks the Mohonk Mountain House as one of the Top 100 Hotels in the World and one of the Top 25 Resorts in the Continental U.S. Upon arrival at this National Historic Landmark, you'll learn about the 149 year history of this beautiful resort and its culinary traditions. Next enjoy a sumptuous buffet lunch in the main dining room. The afternoon is free for you to enjoy the amenities of the resort. There are acres of beautifully manicured gardens, walking trails, a greenhouse, barn museum and a gift shop (carriage rides and spa services are available for an additional fee.). Departing New Paltz this afternoon, you'll travel to Highland, NY and visit the Walkway Over the Hudson. Formerly a railroad bridge, the walkway is now the longest pedestrian bridge in the world. Walking along the bridge, you'll have a bird's eye view of the Hudson River below. Before returning to your hotel in Poughkeepsie, you'll have dinner at a local restaurant. (BREAKFAST, LUNCH, DINNER)

Day Three – Following breakfast at the hotel, we'll depart and travel to Hyde Park, NY and the Culinary Institute of America. Founded in 1946 as a vocational institute for returning veterans of World War II, today it is the world's premier culinary school with campuses in Hyde Park, NY, Napa Valley, CA, San Antonio, TX and Singapore. After touring the campus, you will have lunch in one of the Institute's teaching restaurants. All of the food served in the restaurants are prepared and served by current CIA students. After lunch, the motorcoach will transfer you to the Franklin D. Roosevelt National Historic Site for a tour of Springwood, Roosevelt's home. Late this afternoon you will return to Poughkeepsie. Dinner is on your own this evening. (BREAKFAST, LUNCH)

Day Four – After breakfast at the hotel, we'll depart for Albany, NY. Upon arrival we'll tour the New York State Capitol Building, which has served as the seat of government for New York since the 1880's. The building is a marvel of late 19th-century architectural grandeur, built by hand of solid masonry over a period of 32 years. Following the tour you will have time to explore the Empire State Plaza Art Collection and have lunch (at your own expense) before we depart for Saratoga Springs. Arriving in Saratoga Springs, a local guide will take us on a tour of the historic town and tell you of the history of the natural springs. Dinner is included this evening at a local restaurant. (BREAKFAST, DINNER)

Day Five – Following breakfast and hotel check-out, we'll depart Poughkeepsie and head south to Sleepy Hollow. Upon arrival we'll take a guided tour of Kykuit, home to four generations of Rockefellers. Following the tour, enjoy lunch in Sleepy Hollow (at your own expense) before we take a guided tour of the Union Church of Pocantico Hills. Built with donations from the Rockefeller and Collier families, the church contains stained glass windows designed by renowned artists, Henri Matisse and Marc Chagall. Following the tour, we'll depart for home with fond memories of the Hudson River Valley. (BREAKFAST)

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: All rates are based on a minimum of 30 participants. Should the numbers be less, the cost per person is subject to increase. Insurance benefits are not payable for any loss due to, arising or resulting from: 1. suicide, attempted suicide or any intentionally self-inflicted injury of You, a Traveling Companion, Family Member or Business Partner booked to travel with You, while sane or insane; 2. an act of declared or undeclared war; 3. participating in maneuvers or training exercises of an armed service, except while participating in weekend or summer training for the reserve forces of the United States, including the National Guard; 4. riding or driving in races, or speed or endurance competitions or events; 5. mountaineering (engaging in the sport of scaling mountains generally requiring the use of picks, ropes, or other special equipment); 6. participating as a member of a team in an organized sporting competition; 7. participating in bodily contact sports, skydiving or parachuting, hang gliding or bungee cord jumping; 8. piloting or learning to pilot or acting as a member of the crew of any aircraft; 9. being Intoxicated, or under the influence of any controlled substance unless as administered or prescribed by a Legally Qualified Physician; 10. the commission of or attempt to commit a felony or being engaged in an illegal occupation; 11. normal childbirth or pregnancy (except Complications of Pregnancy) or voluntarily induced abortion; 12. dental treatment (except as coverage is otherwise specifically provided); 13. amounts which exceed the Maximum Benefit Amount for each coverage as shown in the Schedule of Benefits; 14. due to a Pre-Existing Condition, as defined in the Policy.
