ITINERARY

DAY ONE~ARRIVAL~VIRGINIA BEACH Depart early this morning and travel to **Virginia Beach, Virginia**. Morning and afternoon rest stops and a one (1) hour lunch stop (at your own expense) will be made en route. This afternoon, check into your oceanfront hotel **The Holiday Inn North Shore** for the next four (4) nights. Dinner is included this evening at a local restaurant. **MEALS: DINNER**

DAY TWO~INTERNATIONAL TATTOO FESTIVAL

After breakfast at the hotel, enjoy free time at the hotel or on the boardwalk before boarding your motorcoach and heading to Norfolk. Arrive in Norfolk in time for a luncheon with a visit from the **Tattoo entertainers**.

Historically, tattoos stem from a 17th-century European tradition of military drummers alerting soldiers that it was time to return to their barracks for the evening. After hearing the call of the local regiments' fifes and drums, the Dutch Low Country innkeepers would call "Doe den tap toe!" ~ Turn off the taps!" The "tap too" evolved over time, and the word "tattoo" now refers to a ceremonial performance of military music by massed bands.



Later this afternoon, you have premium reserved seats for the **Virginia International Tattoo** – long regarded as the most patriotic of the world's great tattoos – it thrills audiences year after year with an awe-inspiring spectacle of music and might. It's a show of military splendor – part parade and part theater. It offers an astounding display of inspirational military music, majestic massed pipes and drums, show-stopping drill team maneuvers, international bands and dancers, and much more. After the show, you will return to Virginia Beach and your hotel. Dinner is on your own this evening.

DAY THREE~NORFOLK BOTANTICAL GARDENS~VIRGINIA MILITARY AVIATION MUSEUM

After breakfast this morning, you are scheduled for the first tram ride through the Spring Blooms at the **Norfolk Botanical Gardens**. This 175-acre garden has one of the largest collections of azaleas, camellias and rhododendrons on the East Coast.



After the gardens you will tour the **Virginia Military Aviation Museum**, home to one of the largest private collections of World War I and World



War II era military aircraft in the world. Each plane has been beautifully restored to its prior military condition. Enjoy a guided tour on arrival and then you are seated for a **Liberty Call Patriotic Luncheon** in one of the Museum's hangars. Lunch is followed by a musical program with a quartet performing the music of World War II. You will be transported back to the era of Big Band music, jazz harmonies and swinging choreography. Music made famous in the war movies you grew up with. This show includes a grand

finale honoring those who served and are currently serving. Immediately following lunch, you'll move outside to your seats on the tarmac for an afternoon air show. **Historical Aircraft** from either World War II and Korea will start their engines, taxi, takeoff, flyby multiple times before landing in front of the crowd. There will be historical commentary during the show and you will have a chance to meet the pilots and photograph their planes. Returning to your hotel this afternoon, you will have free time to enjoy at the boardwalk or stroll on the beach. Dinner is on your own this evening. **MEALS: BREAKFAST, LUNCH**

DAY FOUR~MACARTHUR MEMORIAL~NAUTICUS~SPIRIT OF NORFOLK



After breakfast board your motorcoach and travel to Norfolk. This morning begins with a visit to the **MacArthur Memorial** dedicated to preserving and presenting the story of the life of **General of the Army Douglas MacArthur**. The Memorial also pays tribute to the millions of men and women who served in World War I, World War II and the Korean War. General Douglas MacArthur was laid to rest in the Rotunda of the



museum. Today the Museum has been expanded into one of the premier institutions in the U.S. dedicated to preserving and presenting the history of these conflicts. Following lunch (at your own expense), you will be transferred to **Nauticus, The National Maritime Center**. It's a high-tech, virtual reality museum that lets you explore the rich life of the ocean realm. Included, is a tour of the Battleship **USS Wisconsin**, the largest battleship ever built by the Navy. This mighty ship was used during World War II, the Korean Conflict and the Gulf War. You'll discover how it earned its five battle stars during WWII.



This evening, celebrate your final night with a Red, White & Blue Spirit of America Farewell Dinner Cruise onboard the **Spirit of Norfolk**. Sail on the Elizabeth River and enjoy dining, dancing, entertainment and breathtaking views of the historic downtown waterfront.
