PAYMENT INFORMATION: A NON-REFUNDABLE deposit of \$350 per person is due along with the reservation coupon in order to confirm your land and air reservation. Final payment and full legal names of all persons traveling are due on or before FRIDAY, JULY 8, 2022. If final payment is NOT received by deadline date, reservation will be automatically cancelled and deposit will be forfeited. No extensions or exceptions will be permitted.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: ALL SPACE IS SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY AT TIME OF BOOKING. ALL RATES ARE BASED ON A MINIMUM OF 32 FULLY PAID ADULT PASSENGERS AND IS SUBJECT TO INCREASE SHOULD THIS MINIMUM NOT BE MET.

PAYMENTS: You may charge any portion or the entire amount to your Boscov's Charge, MasterCard or Visa. If paying by check, make it payable to Boscov's Travel.
