## PASR's Legislative Agenda

1. PASR continues to advocate for a cost of living adjustment (COLA) for school retirees.
2. PASR promotes continued preservation of the defined pension benefit plan of PSERS.
3. PASR promotes efforts to strengthen the Health Options Program (HOP) administered by PSERS. PASR also promotes legislation to maintain or increase the current level of premium assistance that is provided to eligible retirees.
4. PASR supports an increase in the number of retired members who serve on the PSERS Board of Trustees.
5. PASR supports changes to PSERS to increase transparency and to promote investments strategies that best benefit annuitants
