ITINERARY

Day One ~ Departing early this morning, you will head west to Ohio, making a morning and afternoon rest stop and a lunch stop (at your own expense) en route. Late afternoon check-in at the Hampton Inn, Columbus, OH. Dinner is on your own this evening.

Day Two ~ After breakfast at the hotel and check-out, you will depart Columbus and head to Kentucky. Upon arrival in Louisville, you will have free time for lunch on your own. Following lunch, you will have a tour of the Louisville Slugger Factory and Museum where you will see first-hand how the famous bats are made from the selection of the wood to the final product. Then visit Barrels and Billets next door, for a custom bourbon tasting experience. Following Barrels and Billets you will check into the Drury Inn East, Louisville, KY for a four (4) night stay. Enjoy dinner and a performance of *"Singin' in the Rain"* this evening at the Derby Dinner Playhouse. **Meals: Breakfast, Dinner**

Day Three ~ Breakfast is included at the hotel. Following breakfast, depart for Churchill Downs, home of the Kentucky Derby Museum and the Kentucky Derby. Enjoy a self-guided tour of the museum, including two floors of interactive exhibits and view the epic film, *"The Greatest Race,"* a 360°, 18-minute media experience that will make your heart race and emotions soar. Next you will learn about the traditions and lore of the Derby and discover that the Kentucky Derby is as much about watching people as its horses, and enjoy a seminar titled *"Horse Talk"* where you will learn the secrets of picking a winner, including tricks like reading a horse's eyes, ears and tails. You will also take a 30-minute guided walking tour of Churchill Downs Racetrack. Late this afternoon you will visit Fourth Street Live, a dining and entertainment district in downtown Louisville. Enjoy dinner on your own here before returning to the hotel. **Meals: Breakfast**

Day Four ~ After breakfast at the hotel, you will depart for Georgetown, KY to visit Old Friends Thoroughbred Retirement Home. Old Friends Horse Farm is a retirement ranch for at risk racehorses – those whose racing and breeding careers have come to an end. Here they are provided with the dignified retirement they deserve. Following your visit there, you will return to Louisville and take a step back in time for a Prohibition-themed distillery tour. See the "tools" bootleggers used to make moonshine in the early '20s when alcohol was prohibited. Walk among a collection of historical memorabilia of the era. You'll hear true accounts of the crazy and often dangerous things that were done to illegally produce, transport and sell liquor. Experience how they handcraft liquor today and the similarities between now and then. After the tour, wander over to the tasting bar and sample their spirits, including their newest creation, "NULU"™, a Blue Agave Reposado imported from Mexico, then brought home to Louisville to age in bourbon barrels. Dinner is included this evening at a local restaurant. **Meals: Breakfast, Dinner**

Day Five ~ Following breakfast you will visit Old Forester Distillery for an immersion tour that explains the history of the bourbon's hometown, distilling and bottling process and much more. Old Forester was one of only a hand-full of companies given a permit to sell and manufacture whiskey during Prohibition and the only one still in the whiskey business today. The company today is helmed by the fifth generation of the original founding family. At the end of the tour, you can taste their award-winning craft bourbon in the Old Forester Tasting Room. After free time for lunch on your own, you will visit the Evan Williams Bourbon Experience featuring an artisanal distillery and a guided historical tour. Celebrating the legacy of Evan Williams, Kentucky's first distiller, this immersive experience brings to life the history and tradition of Kentucky's native spirit. Your tour will include a demonstration on how to make Kentucky's native cocktail – the Mint Julep. Dinner is on your own this evening.

Meals: Breakfast

Day Six ~ After breakfast and check-out you will depart Kentucky and head for Ohio. Arriving in Cincinnati you will tour the American Sign Museum. The American Sign Museum features 20,000 square feet of more than a century of American signage. From early, pre-electric signs adorned in goldleaf, to the earliest electric signs, to beautiful art-deco neon, to the modern plastic-faced sign, the museum covers it all. Following your visit to the museum, you will continue on to Columbus, where you will check into the Drury Inn, Columbus/Dublin for a one (1) night stay. Dinner is on your own this evening. **Meals: Breakfast**

Day Seven ~ After breakfast and check-out you will head for home, making rest and meal stops along the way. **Meals: Breakfast**

4. war or act of war, including invasion, acts of foreign enemies, hostilities between nations (whether declared or undeclared), or civil war;
5. the commission of or attempt to commit a felony or being engaged in an illegal occupation by You, a Traveling Companion, Family Member, or Business Partner;
6. directly or indirectly, the actual, alleged or threatened use, discharge, dispersal, seepage, migration, escape, release or exposure to any hazardous biological, chemical, nuclear radioactive weapon, device, material, gas, matter or contamination;
7. piloting or learning to pilot or acting as a member of the crew of any aircraft.
